Message from Giri Bharathan, Director, SAFL Program, Samskrita Bharati USA

Namaste,

As we enter the ninth year of SAFL program, I take this opportunity to briefly reflect upon its history and progress made. Based on requests from parents and students interested in learning Samskritam in a formal, structured manner through the school year with the possibility of getting credits, the SAFL program was started in Sep 2009 with 17 students and 3 teachers. It was a learning experience for us as it was the first time we ventured in to teaching online. Currently we have 240 students and 25 teachers. Summer residential programs (Shraddhaa, Prajnaa and Medhaa camps) also have growing enrollment numbers.

The SAFL program was accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges as a supplementary education program in July 2016. It has helped us institute several best practices. New qualified teachers are recruited each year to ensure an optimal teacher:student ratio. Also, we have been trying to increase our engagement with all stakeholders, collect regular feedback and take suitable actions to address their needs. In fact, this newsletter is one such effort.

One of the main purposes of SAFL program is to provide an opportunity for children to get introduced to Samskritam and stay connected with their heritage. They also make friendships with other like minded students during the course of their study. To facilitate continued interaction among the graduates and engagement with Samskrita Bharati, the SAFL Alumni Association has been rejuvenated with the lead taken by some Medhaa shibiram attendees in 2017.

In order to help SAFL graduates connect with other Samskritam enthusiasts at the university level, efforts are being made to extend the reach of the CSN - Campus Samskritam Network, a project started by Samskrita Bharati several years ago to establish Samskritam language clubs in universities. This provides a good opportunity for SAFL alumni to continue learning and also teach Samskritam to others. A few students are in fact currently helping in the SAFL classes and camps. We hope to increase these numbers in the forthcoming years so that the next generation can take a lead role gradually.

SAFL Camps 2017 - Experiences from Students' Perspective

Prajnaa Camp (June 17-23, 2017)

Prajnaa camp has been a wonderful experience for me. The first day when I came to prajnaa camp I was excited to see the room where I would be staying. On the first part of the day, we went inside the main hall and the teacher told us where to go and what we will be doing. At night they told us to go back to our cabins. The cabins looked small but when I went inside I saw 6 bunk beds. There was a small basketball court in front of the cabins where we could play during our free time.

On the second day the teachers told us to come to the main hall where we did yogabhyasam. In the evening, we went outside and played games. The games were really fun. Then we would do bhajans and it was very soothing. In the night we did skits it was fun and entertaining.

On the third day we did hiking. The mountains were a bit steep but it was lot of fun. I had a joyful time looking at the trees and mountains.

On the fourth day when it was dark we did stargazing. The stars looked beautiful. I saw the Milky Way galaxy through the telescope which was awesome.

During the next two days of the camp, we had an excellent opportunity of hearing two great teachers from India who spoke about how to improve our samskritam speaking skills. It was very inspiring.

On the final day of the camp, we played scavenger hunt. It was fun finding clues.

The food served all days in the camp was very delicious and we had a variety of items to choose from. Throughout the camp, we learned about vibhaktis and dhatu pratyayas (noun declensions and verb conjugations). We learned how to pronounce those words verbally. It was fun and interactive. We learned how to listen and read the complex sentences. There were a lot of different types of styles in pronouncing the words. I improved my sambhashanam skills.

We learned how to express the words and write the words in devanagari. We used our understanding for what those words mean. We also learned about suktis and subhashitams which were very interesting and melodic. Subhashitams inspire me a lot. When I listen to the sweet tune it is like the joy and bliss of life. It made me feel happy.

Overall, the whole course was both immersive and interactive. It was one of the best experiences I ever had in my life. I learned quite a lot in these seven days. I especially liked the subashitams because the melody of music was so sweet. I had a great time in prajnaa camp. It has been an exciting journey.
